Applications submitted after the 2024-2025 program deadline will be considered applications for the next cohort year.</p>
	Submit REOC Eligibility Documents	March 8, 2024	<p>Applicants must submit the following <u>required documents</u> in person to REOC Admissions office <u>by no later than 3pm on the deadline</u> date: (see website for full documentation descriptions)</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> Government Issued Photo Identification Proof of New York State Residency Proof of Income Social Security Card </p> <p>All REOC ELIGIBILITY documents must be received <u>prior to scheduling TABE and TEAS assessments.</u></p>
	Complete TABE Test and (if applicable) TABE Re-Test	April 5, 2024	<p>The Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) measures an applicant's reading comprehension and math skills and are applicable to program materials. The TABE is a mandatory test and must be completed for any REOC program applicant. Any TABE results received after the deadline date will be considered for the next PN cohort year.</p> <p>Minimum eligibility TABE scores to schedule the TEAS Assessment:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">TABE 11 or 12 Level M 560(R) and 520(M)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">-or-</p> <p style="text-align: center;">TABE Level D 545(M) and 545(R) (with a test result date no greater than one year prior to current REOC application date)</p>

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	Complete the TEAS Assessment	April 12, 2024	<p>The TEAS Assessment determines further program proficiency of an applicant through evaluation of English and language usage, reading, science, and math. Minimum eligibility TEAS score is proficiency level of 58.7% or greater.</p> <p>NOTE: A TEAS version 7 assessment from another institution will be acceptable if the TEAS has a test result date no greater than one year prior to current REOC application date.</p>
	Program Required Documents	April 19, 2024	<p>After achieving the required TABE and TEAS scores applicants MUST submit all of the REQUIRED Program documents in person to REOC Admissions: Official HS Transcript or Official HSE/GED Transcript, two professional references, and Social Security card.</p>
	Applicant Interviews	April 29-May 17	<p>Once completing all prior requirements, the applicant will be scheduled for a panel interview, which includes faculty, counseling, student, and professional staff. Business professional attire is required.</p>
	Notification of Program Acceptance/Waitlist	Week of June 3, 2024	<p>Applicants will be emailed the final decision of acceptance or waitlist status to the Practical Nursing program.</p>
	Student ID Badges	June 24-26	<p>Accepted PN program students will obtain REOC photo identification.</p>
	PN Program Begins	July 8, 2024	<p>Program overview, orientation, readiness seminars, book and uniform distribution, etc.</p> <p>Students bring COMPLETED REOC Student Health Form Parts 1,2,3 and Signature Page on the first day of the program.</p>
	Nursing Pinning Ceremony ATI Live Review Graduation	May 2025	<p>Pinning ceremony recognizing nursing achievement. Mandatory attendance for ATI Live Review and Graduation Rehearsal. REOC Graduation at the Eastman Theatre.</p>
	Program Outcomes and NCLEX Examination	May and Beyond, 2025	<p>Successful retention, completion, and placement of student program completers are the ultimate outcome of this program. Licensure is earned upon successful passing of the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX).</p>
